

Perimeter Sample Lesson

- **Review Lesson on Perimeter**

Lead a discussion of the word rim. Remind students that the rim of something is a border or path along its outer edge.

Talk about the rim of a basketball goal. Show the class rims of plates, bowls, and glasses.

Also show them the rims of objects which have a variety of shapes—some made up of straight edges and others with irregular edges such as the borders of states or countries on a map.

Remember that the rim of something is a border or path along its outer edge. Rims can have any kind of shape or size.

The distance around the rim of an object or figure is called its perimeter. And like all distances, perimeters are measured in units of length (such as inches, feet, centimeters, miles, etc.).
